FEES: DRAFT HORSE SHOWS - For stall \$18 per head will be charged for each animal. Fees are to be paid when entries are made. Colts occupying stalls to themselves will be charged full price. DO NOT RESERVE EXTRA STALLS FOR TACK; request stalls for the actual number of horses you plan to exhibit.

SHIP-IN PARKING & PASSES: SHIP-INS WILL BE ALLOWED ON AUGUST 13 AND AUGUST 14 ONLY. All entries including ship-ins must be pre-registered. No one will be allowed on the fairgrounds without a stable or ship-in pass. A one-day ship-in parking pass (\$10.00 per vehicle, limit two (2) will be issued to entries not obtaining stalls. This pass will be good only on the day that the horse is showing. Ship-ins will not be allowed to stay overnight on the fair grounds. Ship-ins must vacate within one (1) hour following the completion of their last class. Only two persons will be allowed entrance to the fairgrounds with each horse shipped-in. All others must pay admission.

ADMISSION POLICY: Draft horse exhibitors will be issued two (2) one-day complimentary passes per horse per day.

RULES:

1. **All horses must arrive within the check-in times stated above unless shipped in. SHIP-INS WILL BE ALLOWED ON AUGUST 13 AND AUGUST 14 ONLY.**
2. Horses will be exercised at a time and in a place to be specified by the State Fair; wagons and other equipment will be parked at a place designated by the State Fair.
3. **REFER TO HORSE HEALTH REGULATIONS.**
4. All colts **MUST** be broken to lead and **MUST** be shown under halter.
5. All livestock must be exhibited by owner as entered on entry blank. No substitutions.
6. Exhibitors must exhibit at least **TWO (2)** animals in the Farm Show, except junior exhibitors.
7. No exhibitors may win more than two monies in any class.
8. In hitch classes where more than two (2) horses are shown they may be owned by one (1) or more exhibitor but must be entered under one (1) exhibitors name.
9. All entries should be ready well in advance of class time to avoid delays. If you see more time will be needed please notify the ring steward so consideration may be addressed. The maximum time limit shall be five (5) minutes after the class is called by the ring steward.
10. **Registration papers will be checked for all horses shown under halter, including geldings, for the registered Percheron, Clydesdales and Belgian shows, except stallions and mares under one (1) year of age.** Stallions and mares under one (1) year of age must be eligible to register with the Belgian Draft Horse Corp. of America, the Percheron Horse Association of America, or the Clydesdale Breeders of the USA and must carry the name of animal, date of foaling, and name and number of sire and dam.
11. Mares and geldings of any draft breed, registered or non registered, are eligible for all hitch classes unless limited by the class description.
12. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis if stalling horses. Every attempt will be made to accommodate all requests but space is limited.
13. Management reserves the right to re-divide classes based on the number of participants in each class.
14. In the Farm Show, teams entered in class 16, Best Hitch Team, may not be shown in class 15, Best Farm Team. Teams entered in Class 15, Best Farm Team, may not be shown in Class 16, Best Hitch Team.
15. The SFVW officials shall reserve the right to reject or refuse and to order the removal of any exhibit which, in the opinion of its board of directors/officials, is not eligible or worthy of showing or has not met the livestock health requirements.
16. For junior division classes, the exhibitor shall be no younger than 9 years of age and no older than 18 years of age, as of January 1. All juniors must be accompanied by an adult. The superintendent and/or assistant superintendent has the final discretion regarding the age of the junior driver.

Division 6 — DRAFT HORSE PULL

1. Entry fee \$10.00 per team. Teams which are entered in the Draft Horse Competition may also be entered in the pulling contest by paying the entry fee of \$10.00 per team. No pre-registration is required but all horses must be checked-in by the superintendents by 8:00 a.m. on Friday, August 20.
If your horses are not checked-in, you will not be able to pull. No exceptions.
2. Teams traveling the greatest distance and entered only in the pulling contest MAY be furnished stalls on Thursday night, August 19 if stalls are available. If stalls are not available, teams will be allowed on to the grounds Friday morning, August 20 in time for the contest.
3. All teams will be expected to leave the grounds immediately following the contest.
4. **ADMISSION POLICY:** Each pulling team entry will bereceive three single-day gate passes prior to the fair.
5. All teams will be in the same weight class.
6. A stone boat or sled will be used.
7. Specific rules under which the contest will be conducted are available by request.
